TigerTurf synthetic grass is made from either nylon, polypropylene or polyethylene yarn. These materials are durable, resistant to staining, are UV stabilised and the most suitable materials for synthetic grass



use. The grass is tufted into a rubber-backed polypropylene mat for added durability.

TigerTurf utilises the same technologies as carpet tufting in manufacturing, but have adapted conventional machinery to produce longer tuft lengths. TigerTurf's collective knowledge across its manufacturing plants is one of the reasons that its coveted processes are leading the world in synthetic grass design and production.

## **TigerTurf and the environment**

Drought is a part of Australian life. It is cyclic and a natural part of our climate. Excluding the Antarctic, Australia is the driest continent on earth. Parched landscapes, sports grounds and wilting gardens are inevitable during prolonged drought conditions.

Conserving water is a major initiative everybody can contribute to during times of drought. TigerTurf synthetic grass requires no water - whether it's a sports field or a home lawn. ## TigerTurf FAQs

### What is TigerTurf grass made from?

TigerTurf synthetic grass is made from durable nylon, polypropylene or polyethylene yarn sourced from the world leading European yarn producers.

### How long will TigerTurf last?

The TigerTurf landscape range includes product to suit heavy commercial use right down to light use beautification products with pro-rata product warranties up to 7 years duration. TigerTurf Putting Turf a 5 year warranty.

### Does TigerTurf grass fade?

TigerTurf is UV stabilised for the Australian climate to minimise fading and deterioration.

### What about poolside?

We do not recommend the use of rubber infill in poolside areas – the granules may find their way into the pool. Alternately, use short pile, dense grade products that are adhered to an existing base and due to their structure they require limited infill. Example of short pile is "Putting Turf" or long pile "Envy or Summer Envy" with minimum sand infill only.

### Does the grass get hot in the sun?

Like concrete or even sand on the beach, synthetic grass will be hotter than natural grass under the Australian sun. To overcome this, simply do as you would do at the beach - wear sandals/footwear or lie on a beach towel/rug.

### What about dogs?

TigerTurf is pet friendly. Our synthetic grass has drainage; doesn't stain; and any mess can be scooped and cleaned easily.

### What about life's little accidents?

Synthetic grass is very resistant to staining. Spills can be cleaned easily. Damage to the grass can be repaired, in a similar method to repairing carpet.

### How do I install TigerTurf grass?

Installation of a perfect grassed area is dependent on the workmanship during all stages of the process. DIY installation is made possible by following the TigerTurf installation guide. The grass must be laid on a suitably prepared crushed rock base with correct infill or can be directly glued to a concrete surface.

### Why is infill important?







Once the grass had been installed, it should then be in-filled with the correct specification and quantity of sand and/or rubber. The infill is important because it provides weight to secure the carpet and helps provide support to the grass fibres thereby improving performance in wear and visual appearance of the lawn. Surfaces that have long pile (+25mm) that claim to require no infill have proven over many years to have limited life cycle.'

### Where is it made?

TigerTurf has its own manufacturing facilities around the world. TigerTurf in Auckland has been manufacturing grass for Australia for over 28 years.

	TigerTurf™ Envy Star Product	44mm long blade grass. TigerTurf Envy is a two tone, monofilament grass featuring a nylon thatch for a more natural appearance that requires significantly less sand infill.
	TigerTurf™ Summer Envy Star Product	44mm long blade grass. Positioned alongside Envy, TigerTurf Summer Envy is a two tone monofilament grass featuring a green and light brown polypropylene thatch for a 'real' Australian grass look and feel underfoot. Requires significantly less sand infill.
	TigerTurf™ Meadow	40mm long blade grass. TigerTurf Meadow provides a natural grass appearance by utilising two different styles of yarn: a two tone straight yarn and a texturised support yarn. Requires sand and rubber infill.
	TigerTurf™ Lush	50mm long blade grass. TigerTurf Lush uses two yarns with different heights and shades of green to provide a natural appearance. TigerTurf Lush is regularly specified by landscape architects as a premium life-like surface. Requires sand and rubber infill.
	TigerTurf™ TufTurf XT	40mm long blade grass. TigerTurf XT combines two yarns to create a perfect two tone green lawn with improved memory, meaning the grass stands straighter thereby improving appearance and durability. For medium to high traffic areas. Requires sand and rubber infill.
	TigerTurf™ Putting Turf	15mm dense specialist non directional short pile grass. TigerTurf Putting Turf is ideal for landscaping and golf putting greens. Requires sand infill.
